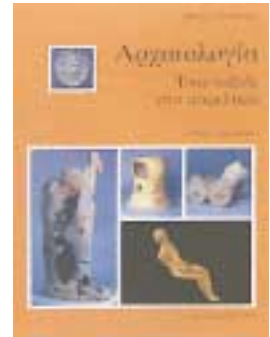
This book aims to introduce science and art to youngsters in a factual and interesting way. Where and how do archaeologists go on with their diggings?
